- **Automated Scoring System** - Screens have been installed and have been received well by the members.
- **Course closed by Superintendent** – The duty person with the mobile phone to be advised, along with the Secretary so a notice is sent out to members. Course closed sign to go out with the Date and Time recorded on it.

On the putting green, players should not stand on another player's line of putt or, when making their stroke, not cast a shadow over their line of putt.



On the putting green, you may:

- Mark, lift and clean your ball (always replace it on the exact spot), and repair ball marks and old hole plugs, but not any other damage, such as spike marks (Rule 16-1).
