- 10 sprinkler heads have been upgraded.
- New rough mower has been delivered.

Deputy Premier, Jacinta Allen, met with members of the Committee, and the following were discussed:

- The Deputy Premier supported our request for a low interest rate loan in the event that the new irrigation system comes to fruition.
- The Police paddock, above the 16th teeing area was briefly discussed in the hope that at some future time said paddock may become available to the Axedale Golf Club for further development for a peppercorn rent/lease arrangement.
